## About Us

Quimper Grange was founded in 1919 as part of a national movement to improve life in rural areas. Originally a mutual aid association for farmers, the Grange is also a community service organization open to everyone.

From the start, Quimper Grange has been about community: people coming together to provide mutual support, to socialize, and to have a voice in legislative decision making. One of the prominent issues this Grange was involved in was the effort to create rural public power (PUDs) in the 1930s.

The Grange building is part of a WWII Army nurses' barracks, moved from Fort Worden to our current location in 1958. With a Merv-13 air filtration system, ADA compliant rest rooms, entry ramp and parking area, the Grange Hall is a gathering place to share food and conversation; to dance and enjoy music; and to share practical knowledge and skills.

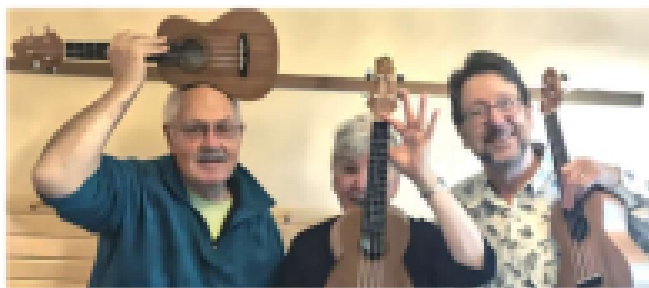
